Relative Pronouns

7 min

A relative pronoun refers to a person or thing mentioned before. It introduces a relative clause. There are 5 relative pronouns.

Relative	Used for	Function	Example
Pronoun			
who	people	subject	The woman <i>who</i> called is a friend.
whom	people	object	The woman <i>whom</i> I called is a friend.
whose	people	possession	The man <i>whose</i> car is here is my brother.
which	things	subject	The car <i>which</i> is coming is Ben's car.
		object	The car <i>which</i> Ben drives is new.
that	people or	subject	The woman <i>that</i> called is a friend.
	things		
		object	The car <i>that</i> Ben drives is new.

Language Tips on Relative Pronouns 5 min

Sometimes we use 'who' for the object in the sentence, instead of 'whom'. It is more formal to use 'whom'.

Examples:

The woman whom I called is a friend. (formal)

The woman who I called is a friend. (less formal)

Sometimes, when the relative pronoun is the object in the sentence, we do not say it.

${\sf Example:}$

The woman I called is a friend.
