



I am winking.	He/She <i>is winking.</i>	They/we <i>are winking.</i>
I am frowning.	He/She <i>is frowning.</i>	They/we are frowning.



When we talk about our face we use the phrase "this is my"


Example:

This is my nose. This is my mouth. This is my ear. This is my forehead.

These are my ears. ("These" is used when we talk about *both* of our "ears") These are my eyes. ("These" is used when we talk about *both* of our "eyes")




