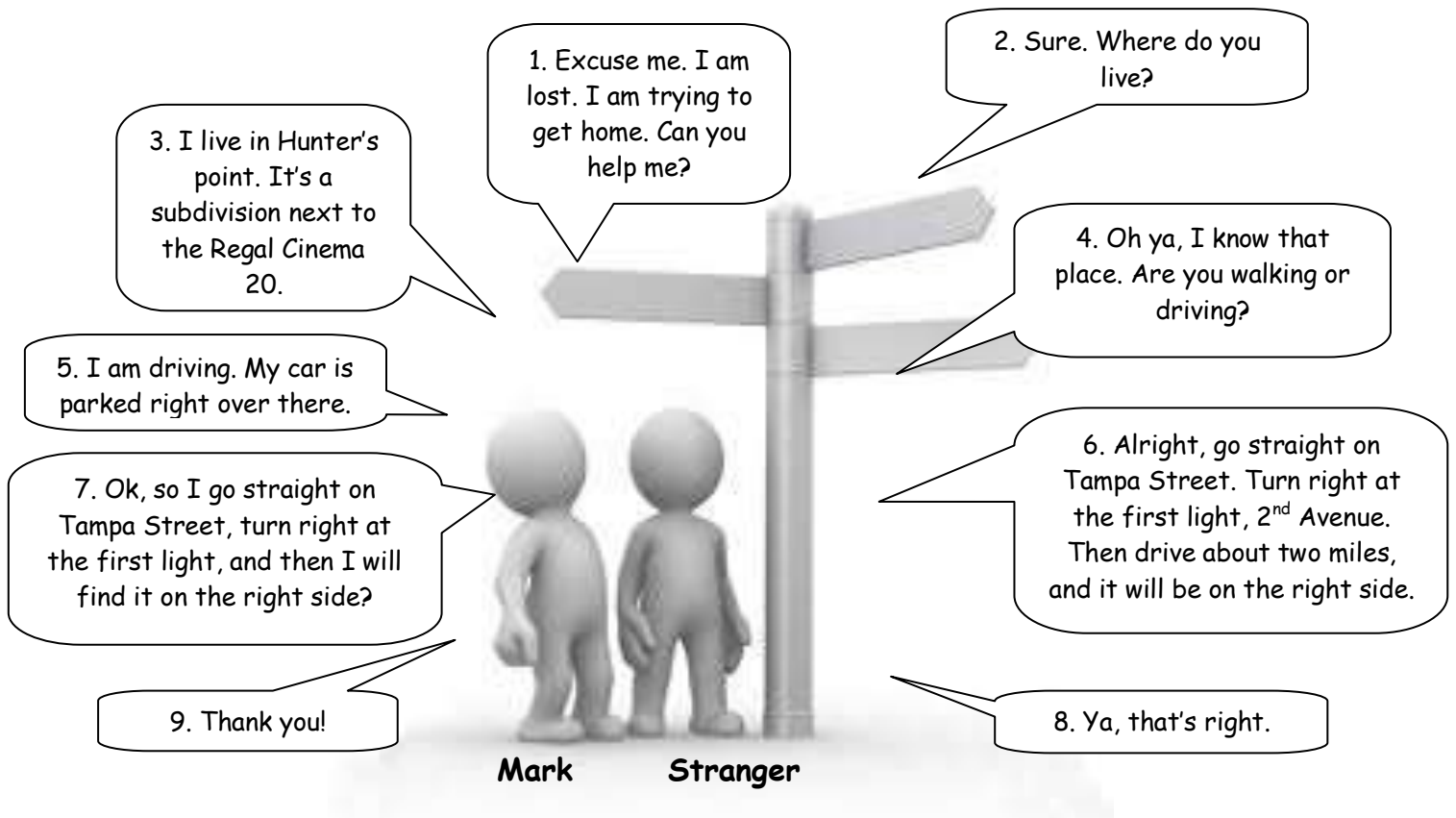

What are they doing?

Mark is lost. He is asking a stranger for directions to his house.

1. Lost - means you do not know where you are
2. Trying to get home - means you are trying to go back to your house
3. "Hunter's point" - is the name of a neighborhood/subdivision
4. Neighborhood/subdivision - many houses near one another
5. Apartment complex - a group of apartments
6. I know that place - means I know where your neighborhood is.
7. Parked right over there - means your car is parked near.
8. Right side - means it is on the right side of the road
9. First light - refers to the 1st traffic signal.

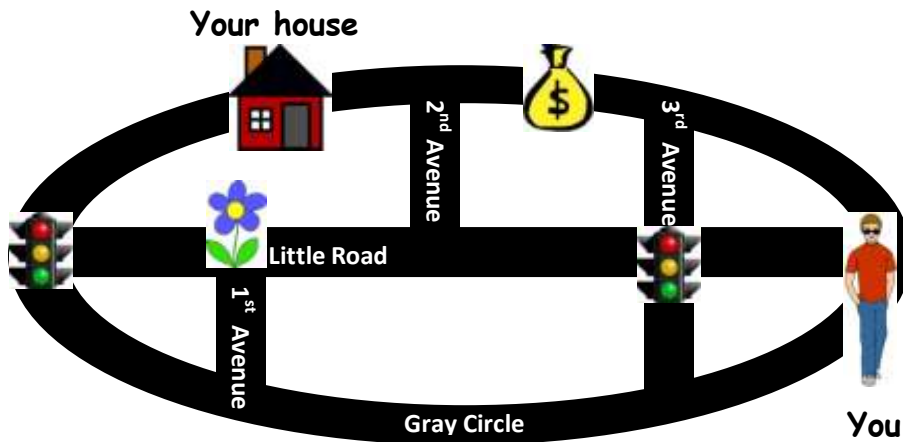
