
GOING OUT (05) At the movies (04) - Discussing the movie (5)

Types of movies:

Comedy - a funny movie Horror/Thriller - a scary movie Romance - a movie about love Romantic Comedy - a funny love story Drama - development of characters that are realistic Mystery - a movie typically focused on crime or solving something Documentary - a movie based on a real story

Language tip 1-2 minutes

A *male* character in a movie is called an "actor."

A *female* character in a movie is called an "actress."

A *lead* actor/actress plays a main role in the film/movie and is sometimes referred to as the *hero*.

A supporting actor/actress play a smaller role in the film.
