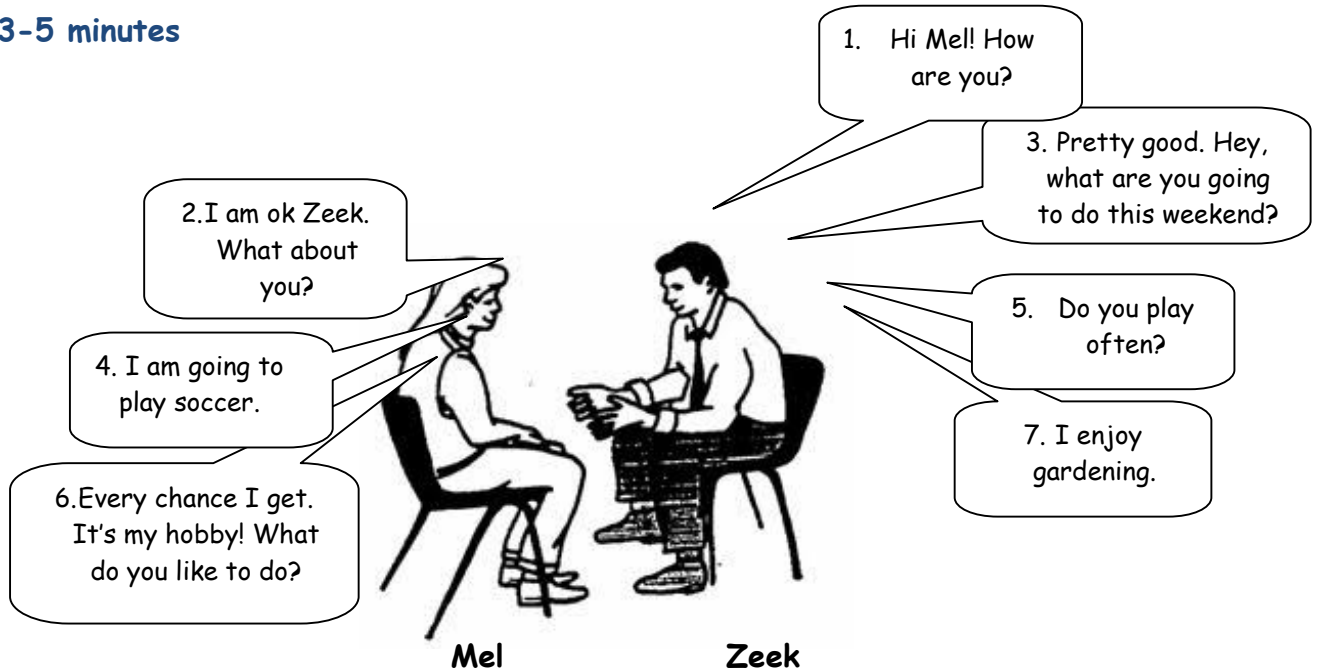


## SOCIALIZING
